Dear Albuquerque Collegiate Families,

The health, safety and well-being of our students, families and staff are paramount, and we remain devoted to delivering on our promise to provide all scholars with the best education possible. We are eager to return to our school building in-person; however, given the current state of COVID-19, we cannot safely ask staff and students to begin in-person learning in August.

We will begin the school year in a fully online learning model.

Online learning will start on August 12th. Scholars will attend three live lessons each day of the school week: Literacy, Math and Enrichment. In addition, every scholar will have two individual meetings with one of their teachers each week. Teachers will also provide weekly assignments and guidance for independent work. ACCS will ensure every scholar can participate in the online learning environment, by providing Google Chromebooks to all scholars who need them.

Please continue to check your email for further updates. We will have individual family orientation meetings on August 10th and 11th, and send more information on those in the coming weeks.

Albuquerque Collegiate will continue to monitor the spread of COVID-19 in New Mexico, with the hope of ultimately returning to in-person instruction. We are here for you, and we are in this together. Please do not hesitate to reach out with questions.
