

**2023-2024 School Year Information**

**Dropoff:** Begins at 7:30am, all scholars are expected to be in the building by 8:00am. Instruction starts at 8:01am. Students will always be escorted from vehicles into the building by staff members. *Scholars arriving after 8:00am will have to be signed in by an adult at the front desk.*

**Dismissal:** Begins at 3:15pm on standard days, and at 1:30pm on Wednesdays. Students will always be escorted from the building to their designated adult pickup by staff members.

**Meals:** Breakfast is served from 7:30am-7:55am. Scholars are not required to eat breakfast, but we want to ensure every student starts the day with a healthy meal, and a full stomach, ready to learn! Lunch is served daily. Students are welcome to bring their own lunch. Soda and candy are never permitted at school, even in lunches brought from home. All students are provided *FREE* breakfast and lunch every day. Students may bring a water bottle for use throughout the school day. *Only water* is permitted in water bottles.

**Recess:** Students will have two monitored recess periods every day on the school's secure/fenced playground.

**Enrichment:** Students will receive 1 enrichment block every day. These enrichment blocks will be focused on physical education and art instruction.

**After-School Program:** After-school care will be available everyday until 6pm. 4th and 5th grade students, and their siblings will attend afterschool at Westside Community Center. Kindergarten-3rd grade students (without older siblings in 4th or 5th grades) will attend the RGEC afterschool program at ACCS.

**Uniforms:** ACCS uniforms must be worn every day. Each student will receive 2 free uniform shirts. Additional uniform shirts can be purchased through our partner vendor. Plain polo shirts and khaki bottoms can be purchased at stores like Walmart, Target, JCPenney, Kohl's, etc.
